PARTICIPANTS

The program will involve outstanding representatives of the private and public sectors of the community. **LEADERSHIP ALCORN** actively solicits and encourages applicants as participants in the leadership program. The Selection Committee will select the participants from the list of applicants. The participants will be selected based on their demonstrated leadership abilities and commitment to Corinth/Alcorn County regardless of their residency. The composite of participants shall present a reasonable cross-section of Corinth/Alcorn County.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance at **LEADERSHIP ALCORN** class programs, including the annual opening conference is critical. Outside of the scheduled daylong programs, required community service also requires a time commitment of 10 hours of community service. Everyone will be accessible in an emergency situation: therefore cell phones are prohibited. These policies will be enforced.

COST

Tuition for the program is \$100 for Alliance Members and \$250 for non-members. The tuition covers meals, programs, materials and transportation. Scholarships may be available based on need.
